

Responsibilities of St. Mary School Parents

Spiritual: be a good example, attend Sunday Mass or worship service weekly, and financially support St. Mary Church.

Service: to build community in our school, **all** school families are required to work 24 service hours per school year. 12 hours **must** be worked at Bingo-3 hours/quarter.
Bingo must be worked by everyone in order to keep tuition low.
